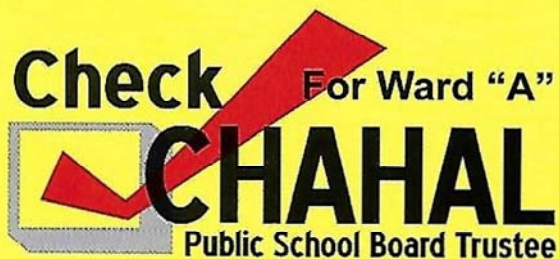


Who will protect education in Edmonton?
